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PURPOSE & OUTCOMES

An extensive, scripturally-grounded training that teaches believers to pray the way the Lord Jesus taught — and to get results. Trainees finish able to:

- › Stand in spiritual warfare — using the Name of Jesus and the power of His Blood.

THE FOUNDATION — PSALM 100:4 + THE LORD'S PATTERN PRAYER

Psalm 100:4 — "Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name."

Every prayer taught in this training follows the pattern the Lord Jesus gave His disciples, mapped onto the movement of Psalm 100:4 — in through the gates, into the courts, before the King, then back out the same way:

1. Enter His gates with THANKSGIVING — approach as a child in relationship with God.

- "Our Father (relationship) who is in heaven, hallowed be Your Name."
- This is our entrance into His gates with thanksgiving.

2. Enter His courts with PRAISE — the royal court.

- Thanksgiving → Praise → Worship.

3. His WILL first — honoring the King in His court.

- "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven."
- Pray for the establishment of His Kingdom on earth.
- Intercession: salvation of others; healing, provision, safety for family, friends, and those who ask for prayer or have need.

4. Our petitions — now it is our turn.

- "Give us this day our daily bread." All your needs are included here. Ask and you shall receive.
- Draw near to God; seek His face; let the Holy Spirit speak words of edification, correction, cleansing, revelation, and comfort (not necessarily in that order).

5. Exit the courts and gates the way we came — WORSHIP, PRAISE, THANKSGIVING.

- "For Thine is the Kingdom, the Power, and the Glory, now and forever. Amen."

This pattern is the template for every prayer taught below.

MODEL PRAYERS – PRAY THESE ALOUD

These eight prayers follow the Pattern Prayer — entering with thanksgiving and praise, interceding for everyone listening, bringing our petitions, and closing in Jesus' name. Pray them aloud as a model, then learn to pray this way in your own words.

1. Anointing & Empowerment

Heavenly Father, we come before you. In the name of Jesus, we enter your gates with thanksgiving and your courts with praise. Thank you for choosing us, setting us apart, and anointing us for your divine purpose. Thank you for the empowerment that comes through your Holy Spirit. We receive your strength and authority to overcome every challenge that comes our way.

We stand firm in faith, knowing that your anointing equips us for victory in every aspect of our lives. Lord, we commit ourselves to living lives set apart for your glory. We earnestly seek your guidance to walk in holiness and dedication, always yielding to your will. We ask that your presence constantly surrounds us and that your favor rests on us.

I lift each individual and family represented by each person listening today. I pray they experience the fullness of your anointing. Let your Holy Spirit empower them, strengthen them, and guide them. May your divine purposes be fulfilled in their lives. Protect them, bless them, and use them mightily for your kingdom.

We proclaim these promises over our lives and the lives of our loved ones. We thank You, Lord, for your anointing and your presence. In Jesus' mighty name, amen.

2. Provision — A Table Before Us in the Presence of the Enemy

Heavenly Father, we are grateful and acknowledge your unwavering love and faithfulness in providing for us. Lord, we thank You for preparing a table before us in the presence of the enemy.

Even in times of great adversity, your provision remains steadfast and generous. Father, we affirm that our circumstances do not limit your ability to bless us. You reveal your glory and kindness in our most challenging moments, meeting our needs abundantly. We choose to trust in your provision, knowing you are our shepherd.

Lord, I lift each person and family listening to these words today. May they experience your

abundant provision in every area of their lives. Let them find comfort in your care, assurance in your promises, and strength in your presence. Protect them from all harm, provide for their every need, and let them see your hand at work despite their struggles.

We proclaim your promise over our lives. You prepare a table before us, care for us, and provide for us. We receive your provision with grateful hearts, worshiping you for your more than enough for us. Thank you, Lord. In Jesus' mighty name, amen.

3. Overflow — Our Cup Runs Over

Heavenly Father, we thank you for your love and generosity. We thank you for the promise that our cup will overflow with your blessings.

Lord, we acknowledge that you are a God of abundance, not just sufficiency. Your blessings surpass our needs and expectations. Father, we praise you for your lavish grace, which fills our lives beyond measure. We stand on your word, believing that in your presence we find not only what we need, but far more than we can ask or imagine.

Lord, I lift up each individual and family represented by everyone listening today. May they experience the overflow of your blessings. Pour out your grace, love, and provision upon them abundantly. Let them see your hand at work, meeting their needs and exceeding their expectations. We pray for an outpouring of your Holy Spirit, empowering us to live in the fullness of your grace.

Let us walk in the assurance of your promises, always grateful, always trusting in your generosity. Let our lives be a testament to your goodness and an overflow of your blessings to others. In Jesus' mighty name, amen.

4. Protection — Our Refuge and Fortress, Under His Wings

Father, we come before you with grateful hearts, acknowledging your unfailing love and protection over us.

We declare that you are our refuge, and fortress in you we trust. Lord, we stand firmly on the promise that nothing can separate us from your love. Father, I lift up every person listening and their families, that you'll cover them with your protective wings and shelter them under your shadow. Let them feel your presence in their lives, knowing they are never forsaken. Lord, help us to always remember the steadfastness of your promises as we face life's uncertainties.

Help us to trust in your guidance. Let your divine love be our guiding light and our sanctuary in times of trouble. We pray that you'll help us so we may live continually under your shadow, covered by your wings, and confident in the strength that comes from knowing we are kept in your love. To you be all the glory and honor, dominion and power, both now and forevermore. Amen.

5. The Blood of Jesus

Heavenly Father, we come before you with grateful hearts, acknowledging the unimaginable power and protection we have in the blood of Jesus. Lord Jesus, we thank you for your blood shed for our redemption. Thank you for your blood which cleanses and grants us victory over the enemy. Father, I pray for every person listening and their families, that you cover them with the precious blood of Jesus.

Let this powerful blood mark their homes and lives so that any form of destruction or disaster must pass over them. Lord, I pray that your blood be their refuge and fortress, a divine signal of your protection and grace. Lord, we proclaim victory over every challenge, every attack of the enemy, and every fear.

We stand firm in the power of the blood of Jesus, confident that we are more than conquerors through him who loved us and gave himself for us. As we go about our lives, let us continually live under the covering of your blood, Lord Jesus. Empower us to walk in the fullness of your promises, reflecting your love and grace. In the mighty name of Jesus, we pray. Amen.

6. Psalm 121 — The Lord Is My Keeper

I lift up my eyes to the heavens. From where does my help come? My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth. He will not allow my foot to slip. My protector will not slumber. Behold, the protector of Israel will neither slumber nor sleep. The Lord is my keeper. The Lord is the shade on my right hand. The sun will not strike me by day, nor the moon by night. The Lord will guard me from all evil. He will preserve my soul. The Lord will watch over my coming and going, both now and forevermore.

Thank You, Lord. I pronounce Your living words I just spoke over myself, my family, and everyone listening. Let us all experience the fullness of these prayers in our lives. Cover us with Your divine protection, shield us from every attack, and vindicate us against every false accusation. Let Your peace, joy, strength, and assurance fill our hearts as we give glory to You. In Jesus' name.

7. Isaiah 54:17 — No Weapon Shall Prosper

Father, we thank You for Your powerful promise in Isaiah 54:17. We declare that no weapon formed against us shall prosper. We stand on Your Word and condemn every tongue that rises against us in judgment. We arise and embrace our heritage as Your servants and acknowledge that our righteousness is from You.

Lord, I pray for everyone listening to this message. Let them experience the fullness of this promise in their lives. Cover them with Your divine protection, shield them from every attack, and

vindicate them against every false accusation. Let Your peace, strength, and assurance fill their hearts. Bless their families, Lord. Surround them with Your love and protection. Let no harm come near their dwelling. May they walk in Your righteousness and inherit all the blessings You have promised.

We thank You, Lord, for Your faithfulness. We stand firm in Your Word and rejoice in the victory You have given us. In Jesus' mighty name, we pray. Amen.

8. Healing — By His Stripes We Are Healed

Heavenly Father, we are grateful for Your unfailing love and Your promises of healing. We stand on Your Word, believing that by Jesus' stripes, we are healed.

As we confess with our mouths and believe in our hearts, we activate Your healing power in our bodies, minds, and spirits. Father, I lift up every person here and their families. We declare Your promises over their lives, proclaiming health, wholeness, and restoration. Lord, we align our words with Your truth, and we receive healing for anyone who is sick and is listening or reading these in Jesus' name.

We confess that such a person is healed right now in Jesus' name, for by Your stripes, he or she is healed. We hold fast to this confession, knowing that You are the Lord our healer. Thank You, Father, for Your healing touch upon our lives. We praise You for Your faithfulness and for fulfilling Your Word as written. Help us to continue to walk in faith, declaring Your Word and experiencing Your divine healing. In Jesus' mighty name, we pray. Amen.
